

What is CRHP?

Christ Renews His Parish, sometimes called CRHP (pronounced “chirp”), is a parish-based retreat and renewal experience which offers men and women the opportunity to become acquainted with other parishioners, while deepening and strengthening their own relationship with Christ.

What CRHP is Not:

- It is not a silent retreat.
- It is not a public confession.
- It is not a parish clique.

What happens during the weekend?

The weekend is a chance to get away from daily pressures, and provides an opportunity for reflection and spiritual renewal through prayer, scripture, and connecting with others. CRHP has proven to be a faith-deepening and life-changing weekend for many.

Most who have participated in the weekend experience say that, “you can’t explain what happens; you have to experience it”. This is your invitation to that “experience”.

Praying for guidance is important. If you feel that Christ, through the Holy Spirit or through a human mediator, is calling you... *come!*



Who conducts the weekend?

The CRHP weekend is conducted by a team of parishioners that have attended previous weekends.

Who may participate?

Christ Renews His Parish weekend retreats are open to any Holy Spirit parishioner age 21 or older. You may join no matter where you are on your faith journey!

How long will it last?

The weekend runs from 8:00 a.m. on Saturday to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.

What about Sunday Mass?

There will be a special celebration of the Eucharist for those attending.

I don't like to get up and talk in front of people. Will I be required to?

No one is required to get up and speak. You may share in conversation as much or as little as you choose.

Where do people sleep?

The retreat is held at the Parish Life Center at Holy Spirit. The sleeping accommodations are comfortable. You may bring an air mattress, sleeping bag, pillow and other personal necessities.

Will my snoring disturb others?

Separate sleeping arrangements for those who snore can be arranged.

How should I dress?

Wear something casual and comfortable. Jeans or sweats are acceptable, and layers are advisable.

What about meals?

Hot meals are served. The food is excellent and the portions are ample. There will be regular breaks for coffee, cold drinks, and snacks. Special dietary needs can be accommodated. Please let us know any special needs when you register.

I would like to attend, but I have a health problem.

Note your health problem on the Registration Form and discuss it with the Spiritual Director. A recommendation will then be made.

What is the cost of the weekend?

There is no cost to you. All meals and snacks are provided.

How do I know this is the right time for me to attend CRHP?

1. You need some time to put away the to-do list and just breathe.
2. You've been considering doing this for a long time and this time you can clear your calendar
3. It seems that everyone you meet keeps telling you how much they enjoyed the CRHP weekend.
4. You have this unshakable sense that you could be closer to God.
5. God seems closer than ever to you and you want to savor / share the experience.
6. You want your neighbors/friends/spouse to quit nagging you to experience Christ Renews His Parish.
7. You can't say why, but something keeps nudging you to sign-up on the website/put your name on the list or call to register (contact information on the other side).
8. Everyone else at Holy Spirit seems to know lots of people and you wish you knew more people too.

If any of these describe you, it's time that we see you at Christ Renews His Parish.
