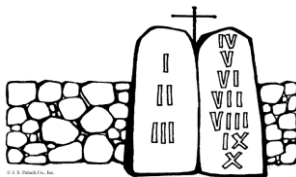

Each Scrutiny looks at a different gospel specifically chosen to remind us of an important aspect of becoming a disciple through baptism. 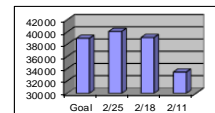
