Fr. Thomas Hemm, C.P.P.S. will be with us next weekend to ask your support for the work of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. The Mass is open to all parishioners and the Mass intentions from the previously scheduled noon Masses will be celebrated at the 9:30 Masses. Fr. Coady and I will both take turns celebrating the Masses. Thank you for your continued support of our outreach and I apologize for any inconveniences this may cause people during the transition period.

Boys' CYO Football
