## Unexpected Grace

### Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

Jesus feeds thousands of people in this week's gospel by making bread and fish multiply from nothing. If this is the first time one has heard the story, it is amazing. If it is the fiftieth time one has heard it, perhaps it loses some of its awe-inspiring power.

One detail, however, is particularly striking. Jesus' apostles note that it would take 200 days wages of the average worker to feed everyone gathered. The equivalent sum is about \$19,000 for one simple meal. Perhaps this helps us understand the scope of what Jesus did. And on top of performing this miracle, Jesus has even provided for leftovers. He doesn't just give everyone what they need, he gives them an unexpected abundance.

God works this way throughout Scripture and especially in our lives. There is unexpected grace – God's gift of love and mercy – waiting in every corner of our lives. God wants to give us an abundance of it, not just what we need to make it through the day.

To learn more about the offer of God's abundant love, join us for Summer Inquiry meetings. Inquiry is an informal session to meet Holy Spirit staff and parishioners and to ask questions about following Jesus as a Catholic Christian. Meetings take place every Monday, year-round, at 7:00 PM in the Parish Life Center. Just show up any week and we'll be happy to sit and chat.
