High School Girls' Volleyball

Signup is online at www.hsgathletics.org for high school girls' volleyball. This is open to parish girls who will be in high school this fall.

Grade School Girls' Basketball

Signup is online at www.hsgathletics.org for grade school girls' CYO basketball. This is open to parish girls who will be in grades 4 through 8 this fall. Practices begin in late August and the season runs from early October through early November. There is typically no conflict with the school basketball season, so girls should be able to play this even if they are playing for their school teams.
