Scribes, Widows, and Hardened Hearts



Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

At first glance, Jesus’ words in this week’s gospel may strike us as particularly condemning of the Jewish faith. He seems to be criticizing the educated class of scribes who serve as preservers of Scripture and serve as the prayer leaders to the community. However, Jesus was one of these educated people who could read and write and served as a teacher and spiritual leader.

He is not condemning all scribes and rabbis, here. Jesus was a faithful Jew. Rather, he is calling to task those scribes who value the honor of their position over and above the service of God. He contrasts this with the poor widow, a woman with no means of support or any standing in the community, who quietly gives a substantial portion of her money to the service of God. She is unseen by those too caught up in their own pride, but she is noticed and praised by Jesus.

Whether we need to let go of our pursuit of worldly praise or we are serving God quietly and faithfully, Jesus wants to bring us into God’s kingdom. Only those who are too hard-hearted to let go of the accolades are left without a seat at the table of the Lord.

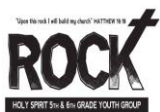
